The Project Fiduciary Management Unit (PFMU) of the Ministry of Finance now invite sealed Bids from eligible bidders who can demonstrate Technical and Financial Capabilities for Road Improvement on the West Corridor from Juba to the Central Business District with Signalization at Selected Intersections.

3. Bidders shall quote for all items as required in the Bid Document. No partial quotation will be accepted. Bids will be evaluated, and contract will be awarded to the Bidder meeting the required qualification criteria.

4. Bidding will be conducted through International Competitive Bidding (NCB) procedures specified in the World Bank Procurement Regulations for Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers July 2016 Revised November 2017 and August 2018 and is open to all eligible bidders as defined in the guidelines and as set forth in the Public Procurement Act 2016.

The bidding document may be purchased by interested eligible Bidders upon payment of a non-refundable fee of Two Million Leones (**Le2,000,000**) and bidders may obtain further information on the bidding document at the address below between 11:00 am to 4:00pm from Mondays to Fridays no-later than five (5) days prior to the deadline of submission of bids. The method of payment will be cash.

7. All Bids must be accompanied by a Bid Security in the amounts indicated above or its equivalent in a freely convertible currency. The Bidder shall seal the original and each copy of the bid, in separate envelopes, duly marking the envelopes as “**ORIGINAL (1)**” and “**COPY (3)**.” The envelopes shall then be enclosed in an outer envelope and sealed.

8. Bids must be delivered to the address below on or before 11:00 am on **Friday 24th April, 2020** Electronic Bidding will *not* be permitted. Late Bids will be rejected. Bids will be publicly opened in the presence of the Bidders’ designated representatives and anyone who chooses to attend at the address below at 11:00 am on **Friday 24th April, 2020**.
