TRANSFER OF DEVOLVED FUNCTIONS AND ADMINISTRATIVE GRANTS TO LOCAL COUNCILS FOR THE FIRST HALF OF FY 2020

The Ministry of Finance is pleased to inform the General Public that the Government of Sierra Leone has remitted a total amount of **Le17,666,257,633** as transfers for devolved functions and Government support grants to defray the administrative expenses of Local Councils for the first half (Jan-June) of FY2020. These funds have been paid into the Bank Accounts of all Local Councils.

This payment is in addition to **Le35,935,099,190** disbursed to Local Councils in May 2020 for the same purpose.

Also, the Ministry of Finance wishes to inform the General Public that, the Government has paid the sum of **Le678,000,000** to 16 Local Councils as grants to support operations of the Free Quality Education School Buses for the period (June - August 2020).

Upon receipt of these funds, Local Councils **MUST** transfer them to the various devolved sector accounts as per schedule sent to them. Also, Local Councils **MUST** display details of such devolved sectors, including amounts, on Council's Notice Boards, and other public places in order to provide access of this information to the General Public.
