The Government of Sierra Leone has received financing from the African Development Bank (AfDB) towards the cost of Post Ebola Recovery Social Investment Fund (PERCIF) and intends to apply part of the agreed amount for this grant to payments under the contracts for **Designing, Supervising and Monitoring the Rehabilitation and/or Construction Works for Health and Wash Facilities and Multi-Purpose Trade Facilitation, Information and Learning Centres** in communities.
2. The services to be undertaken include:
 - ❖ **Category:**
 - Design, Supervise and Monitor the Rehabilitation and/or Construction of Health Facilities. These include: 5 Community Health Posts/Centres (CHPs/CHCs); 2 Maternity Centres; and 7 Nurses' Quarters.
 - Design, Supervise and Monitor the Construction of 4 Multi-Purpose Trade Facilitation, Information, and Learning (MTFIL) Centres in selected communities in 4 Districts.
 - ❖ **Category2:** Design, Supervise and monitor the Installation/Construction of WASH Infrastructures and Services in Schools, PHUs and Communities, comprising of the following:
 - 118 Toilets of various types and designs- (a) Pour Flush; and (b) Dry Sanitation/Pit Latrines.
 - ❖ **Category 3:** Design, Supervise and monitor the Installation/Construction of WASH Infrastructures and Services in Schools, PHUs and Communities, comprising of the following:
 - 106 Boreholes/Water Supply Systems of mainly two types: (a) Solar-Powered; and (b) Hand-Pumped Systems.
 - Public Dry Sanitation Facilities in 11 Communities.
3. The Ministry of Finance in a capacity as the Fiduciary Agent, through the Project Fiduciary Management Unit (PFMU) now invites eligible Consulting firms to express their interest in providing the aforementioned services. Interested Firms must provide adequate and appropriate

information, demonstrating that they have the required competencies, personnel with the requisite qualifications and relevant experience (capacity and capability) to perform the services.

4. Eligibility criteria, establishment of the short-list and the selection procedure shall be in accordance with the African Development Bank's Procurement Policy dated October 2015, which is available on the Bank's website at <http://www.afdb.org>. The Combined Quality and Cost Selection Method will be used for evaluation of proposals from the shortlisted consultants.
