TRANSFER OF DEVOLVED FUNCTIONS AND ADMINISTRATIVE GRANTS TO LOCAL COUNCILS FOR THE SECOND HALF OF FY 2020

The Ministry of Finance is pleased to inform the General Public that the Government of Sierra Leone has remitted the total amount of **Le52,998,772,898** as transfers for devolved functions and Government support grants to Local Councils for the second half (July to Dec) of FY2020. These funds have been paid into the Bank Accounts of all Local Councils.

This payment is in addition to **Le17,666,257,633** disbursed to Local Councils in July 2020 for First half of the year. Therefore, the cumulative transfers to Local Councils for FY 2020 is **Le70,665,030,531**

Upon receipt of these funds, Local Councils **MUST** transfer them to the various devolved sector accounts as per schedule sent to them. Also, Local Councils **MUST** display details of such devolved sectors, including amounts, on Council's Notice Boards, and other public places in order for the General Public to have access to the financial flows.
