The Government of Sierra Leone through the Ministry of Social Welfare (MoSW)) has received a Grant from the African Development Fund (AfDB) hereinafter called the Bank toward the cost of the Post-Ebola Recovery Investment Fund (PERSIF) Project, and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contract for the supply and delivery of Medical Drugs and Equipment for three (3) newly constructed Community Health Posts (CHPs) in Kenema, Kailahun and Port Loko Districts and Furniture and Equipment for three (3) Multi-Purpose Trade Facilitation, Information and Learning (MTFIL) Centres in Falaba, Kono and Kailahun Districts; and three Nurses Quarters in Kenema, Kailahun and Port Loko Districts.
For this contract, the PERSIF Project shall process the payments using the Direct Payment disbursement method, as defined in the Bank's Disbursement Guidelines and procedures for Investment Project Financing, except for those payments, which the contract provides to be made through a letter of credit.

The Project Fiduciary Management Unit (PFMU) of the Ministry of Finance (MoF) acting as project fiduciary agent for the PERSIF Project now invites sealed Bids from eligible Bidders for the supply and delivery of Medical Drugs and Equipment for three (3) newly constructed Community Health Posts (CHPs) in Kenema, Kailahun and Port Loko Districts and Furniture and Equipment for three (3) Multi-Purpose Trade Facilitation, Information and Learning (MTFILs) Centres and three (3) Nurses Quarters as follows:
